# Induction Day

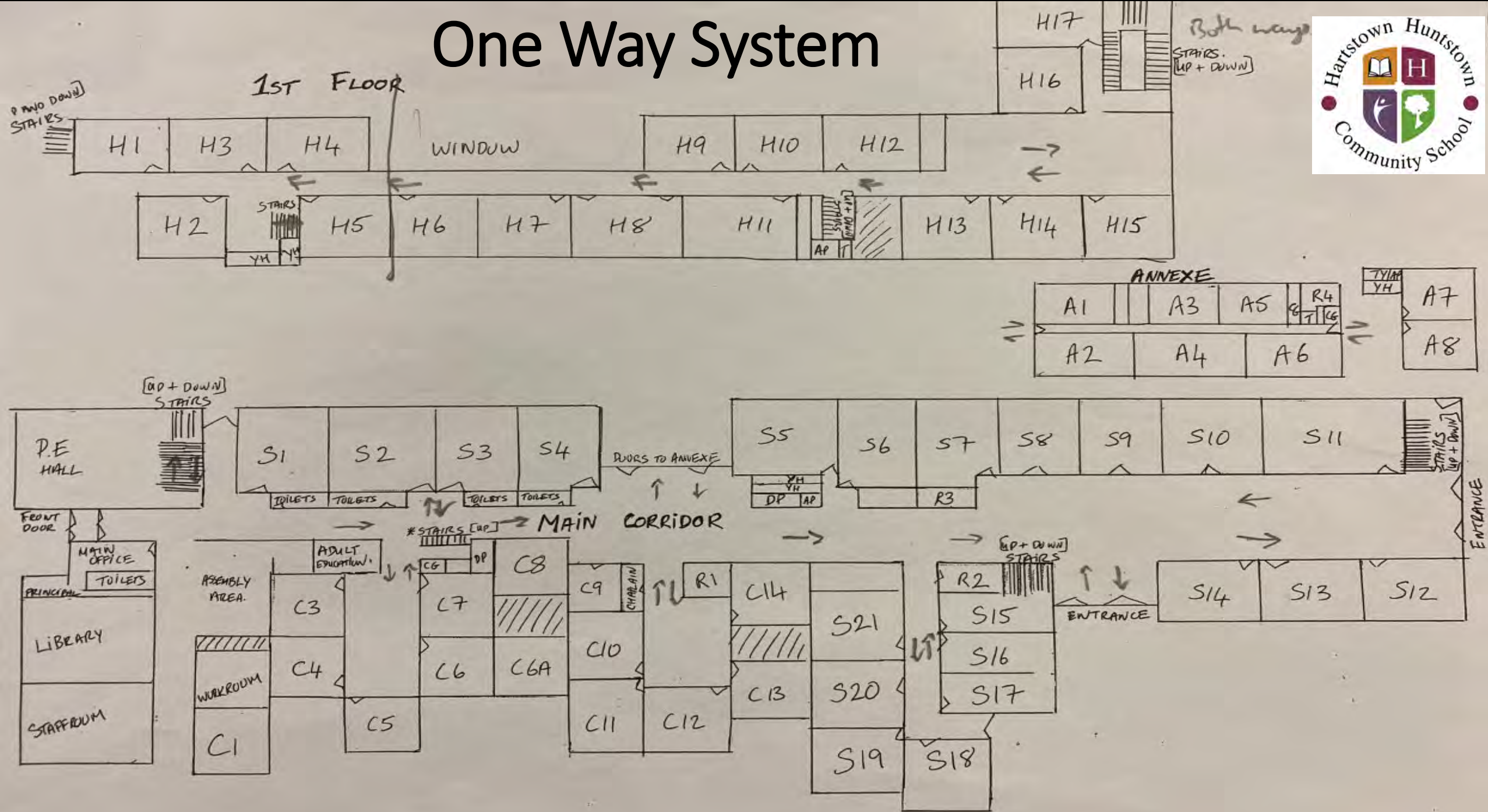


# Typical School Day

# New Classroom Rules

- On entering the classroom students will sanitise their hands at the station on the way in.
- Students will go straight to their assigned seat.
- Students will sanitise their work station at the end of every class
- Students will sanitise their hands on the way out of the classroom
- Students can not share equipment with others



# Lockers

- Students will not have access to lockers
- Students should organise their books for the morning & afternoon classes the night before coming to school



## What if a student feels unwell?

- Students should **not** come to school if they have any COVID 19 symptoms.
- If a student feels unwell throughout the day, we will phone the parents immediately to come and collect the student.



# Good Respiratory Measures

- Masks must be worn above nose and mouth
- Messing with masks will not be tolerated
- Students should avoid touching the face, eyes, nose and mouth
- Students should cough and sneeze into their elbow
- Students must dispose of tissues in a bin



# Entering the building after lunch

- Students will enter the school at the entrance which is closest to their first class.
- Students **must** wear a mask





# Lunch

- We are restricted with the number of students who can stay in school for lunch, students must complete a form if they want to stay in the school at lunch time
- Students will not be able to use the canteen facilities, they must bring all of their own lunch, cutlery etc and this must be brought home with student.
- Students will have to sanitise their lunch area when they are finished.

# PE



- All changing rooms are out of use
- Students with PE timetabled for the morning time will wear PE uniform in the morning and change during lunch.
- Students with PE timetabled for the afternoon will change into PE gear during lunch.
- PE uniform must be appropriate
- Uniforms should be cleaned when PE uniforms are being worn.

# Exiting the Building @ 11.40 & 15.20



- Students will exit the building at 11.40 and 15.20 at their nearest exit.
- Students must leave the building promptly to allow cleaning staff to commence their work.



# Frequency of Hand Hygiene

- before and after eating and preparing food
- after coughing or sneezing
- after using the toilet
- where hands are dirty
- before and after wearing gloves
- before and after being on public transport
- before leaving home
- when arriving/leaving the school /other sites
- after each class
- after touching potentially contaminated surfaces
- if in contact with someone displaying any COVID-19 symptoms
